

Activity	Obwisana	Level: Grade 4 - 6	Heather	Nail
Learning Intentions	 Singing a traditional Ghanian folk song Beat competency Exploration of meter Creation of a stick pattern Form, including Coda 			
Materials Needed	 "Sticks"; pencils, dowels, wooden spoons Drum (teacher) Form visuals (optional) 			
Process	 Sing song and teach by rote. Point out the different phrase endings (re re mi/re re do). Discuss the translation. Keep the beat while singing. Try patterns of 2 (pat-clap), patterns of three (pat-clapsnap), and patterns of 4 (pat-clap-cross-snap). What patterns work the best with the song? (2 and 4) Transfer body percussion patterns to the "sticks" (pencils or wooden spoons). Demo and allow time for students to create and practice. Allow time for student creation; in patterns of 4 what options can you create? Tap the bottom of tops of the sticks, flip the sticks, tap on different body parts, be creative! Perform song (drum accompaniment optional) as a chain rondo: A (song), B (pattern of 2), A, C (pattern of 3), A, D (pattern of 4), A, E (students own creation), A, Coda
