Tapestry Instrument Kits: All classes require instrument kits, if possible, enough for one instrument per student. If you already own an instrument kit, you are not required to purchase another.

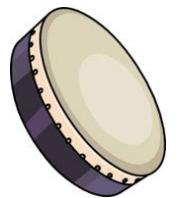
