


# Learning Intentions

- Socialization
- Phrase length recognition
- Creative movement
- Rhyming words
- Accents
- Bordun

## Challenge

- Ask one student to play the triangle on the last "bye" in Section C and a second student to shout out a new movement!
- You can't have the same partner twice! No partner? No problem! Raise your hand and attract another like a magnet!
- Add a solid bordun to Section A, NPP to the beat on Section B and a fancy hi hat cymbal to Section C!
- On the interlude add some chording on the piano!



## **Zoom Zoom - Teaching Process**

#### **Share Summer Movement Activities**

- Share types of movement activities experienced over the summer. Record. (Skateboarding, biking)
- invite students onto the floor in a scattered form.
- Play the drum to a 16-beat phrase as students move around the room in different way.
- Invite students to choose movements. Encourage levels (high, med and low) and directions.
- Ask students to turn to whoever is closest to them at the end of the phrase. Change moves.

### Level I - Part A and B

- Ask students to take a seat on the floor.
- Teach Zoom Zoom Zoom through the echo process.
- Have students join you in body percussion pattern (patsch, snap :II).
- Keep this pattern going as you demonstrate part B saying your name and a movement activity you did over the summer.
- Invite different students to try saying their name with the movement activity as the class accompanies with body percussion.
- Ask students to turn to the person next to them and try. Students decide who starts first.

## Try Part A and Part B together.

\*Choose a movement to start with as you sing song. Turn to someone close on the last beat for Part B. On the rest of Part B have one student shout out a new activity.

## Level II - Part A, B and C

- Teach Part C through the Echo Process.
- Add in the body percussion (patsch, clap, snap Z)
  \*watch upbeat! "Dee is on the patsch"
- Brainstorm different ways of doing a fancy bow and a stylish goodbye.
- Turn to a neighbor and create a hello and goodbye
- Add in the first phrase saying name with BP, the second phrase just your creative bow and goodbye
